



Local residents, organizations, and municipalities are moving forward with actions from *A Climate Action Plan for Waterloo Region: Living Smarter in 2020*.



## ELECTRIC VEHICLES (EV) AND CHARGING NETWORK

There are now 82 EVs in the region and 11 public charging stations with the **Region of Waterloo** and **Sustainable Waterloo Region** leading plans for more installations by the end of the year.

## COMMUNITY BIKE SHARE SYSTEMS

The **Working Centre's Community Access BikeShare** program has grown to five distribution stations in Kitchener-Waterloo, 60 bikes, and 100 members.




## ZERO-IMPACT SUSTAINABILITY INCUBATOR

With **Sustainable Waterloo Region** as lead partner, plans for this sustainability hub are moving forward and the selection of foundational partners and a building site will be taking place this August.



## CORPORATE SECTOR REDUCTION COMMITMENTS

The Marsland Centre became the first Collaborative Facility member of **Sustainable Waterloo Region's Regional Carbon Initiative (RCI)**. This new RCI membership type helps landlords and tenants to partner on GHG reduction projects.



## WATER EFFICIENCY TARGET

Due to region-wide success, the **Region of Waterloo's Water Efficiency Master Plan** has exceeded its goal. The updated plan anticipates a savings of 1370 million litres a year, which will prevent an estimated 7700 tonnes of CO<sub>2</sub>e from being released into the atmosphere.



Savings will power **25,000 homes** for 1 year

## CONSERVATION & DEMAND MANAGEMENT (CDM) INITIATIVES

Current **saveONenergy** programs have resulted in more than \$10,000,000 in incentives being given away by **Cambridge and North Dumfries Hydro, Kitchener-Wilmot Hydro, and Waterloo North Hydro**, which translates to \$25,000,000 of economic investment in our community and enough energy saved to power 25,000 homes for one year. More good news is that the CDM programs were granted a new six-year life, beginning in 2015.
